MANCHESTER ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION BASEBALL FIELD RULES AND REGULATIONS

IN GENERAL

Adopted by Manchester Athletic Association (MAA) as of May, 2007, the following rules and regulations provide for the safe, enjoyable use of the facilities for the protection and safety of all visitors. These rules and regulations apply to the ball field area, including stands, fields, restrooms, parking area and all common grounds.

- The Manchester Athletic Association is responsible for the ballfield area, including stands, fields, restrooms, parking area along County Farm Road and common grounds. MAA is NOT responsible for the pavilion and the playground. Those are maintained by the Manchester Civic Association.
- The Manchester Fire Department owns and operates the firehouse buildings.
- No parking is permitted on the concrete in front of the Manchester Firehouse building.
- All areas, amenities, and facilities located in the ballpark area are open for specific baseball and softball related recreation year round during daylight hours.
- No person is allowed on the ballfield, playground or pavilion between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise, except when games are being played.
- Do not litter. Help keep the ballpark areas clean by using conveniently placed trash receptacles for all garbage and rubbish.
- WE RECYCLE. Please place your cans in the proper containers.
- Clean-up of the baseball areas after use is the responsibility of the person using the facility. Any person(s) using the ballpark who fails to clean-up trash or other debris left by his/her use shall be held liable to MAA for all costs incurred in removing such trash and debris.
- Trespassers and Violators will be Prosecuted , including restitution of property damages.

RULES & REGULATIONS

The following items and activities are strictly PROHIBITED on the grounds:

- Alcoholic beverages,
- Commercial activity except pursuant to a specific contract with the Township or MAA .
- Damage or vandalism to any facility, amenity, tree, or shrub;
- Littering, Drugs or Gambling of any type;
- Profanity, recklessness and/or rowdy behavior are prohibited.
- Loud noise or music without prior approval of the Township or MAA;
- Motorized equipment or vehicles, except in the parking lot; Skateboards or scooters not permitted
- Pets or farm animals including but not limited to horses, dogs, cows, sheep, etc;

RISKS and LIABILITIES

All vehicles and spectators on township property act at their own risk. Manchester Township, the Manchester Athletic Association, Manchester Civic Association, its elected and appointed officials, departments, agencies, employees, volunteers and agents bear no risk for damage or personal injuries to spectators, their vehicles or personal property including those without permission to use the facilities.
